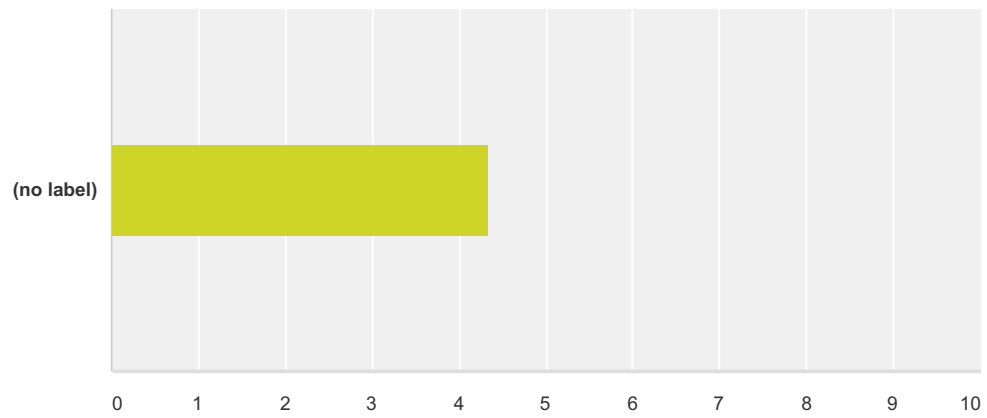

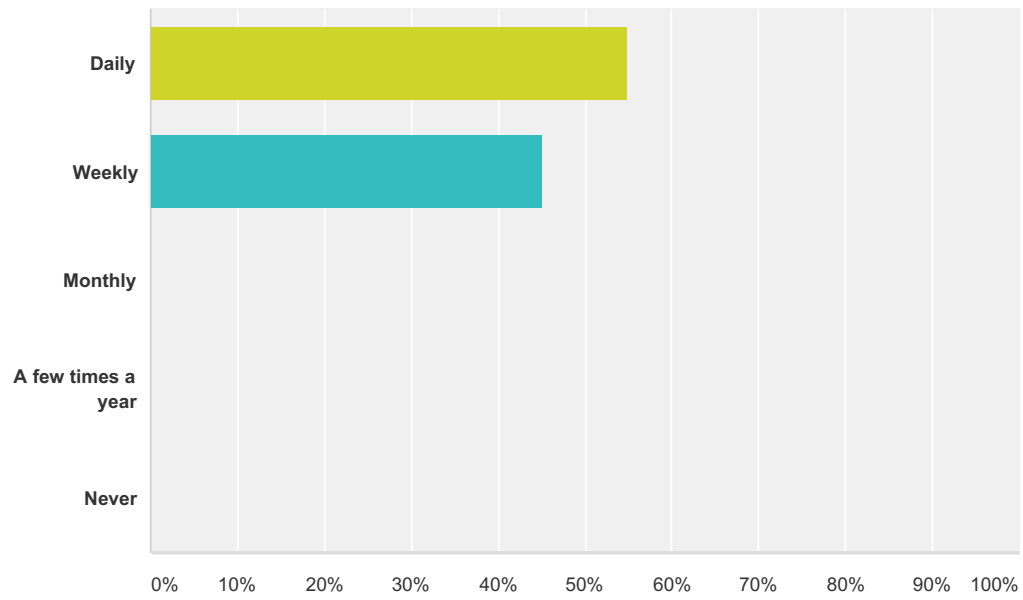

Q6 How often do you go outside for fun/exercise?

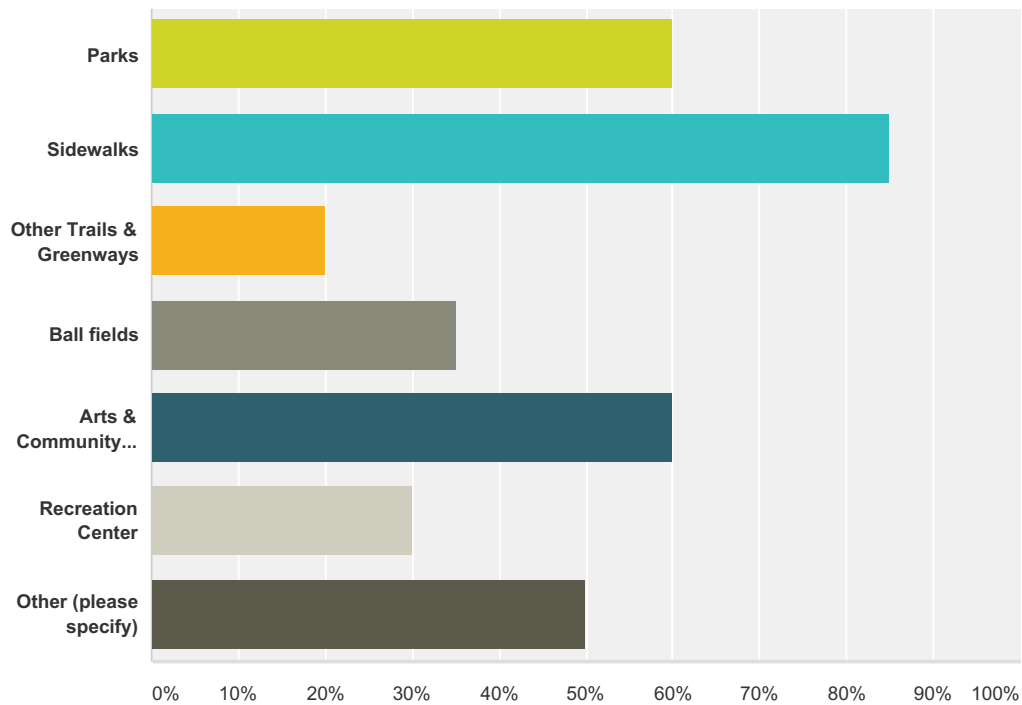

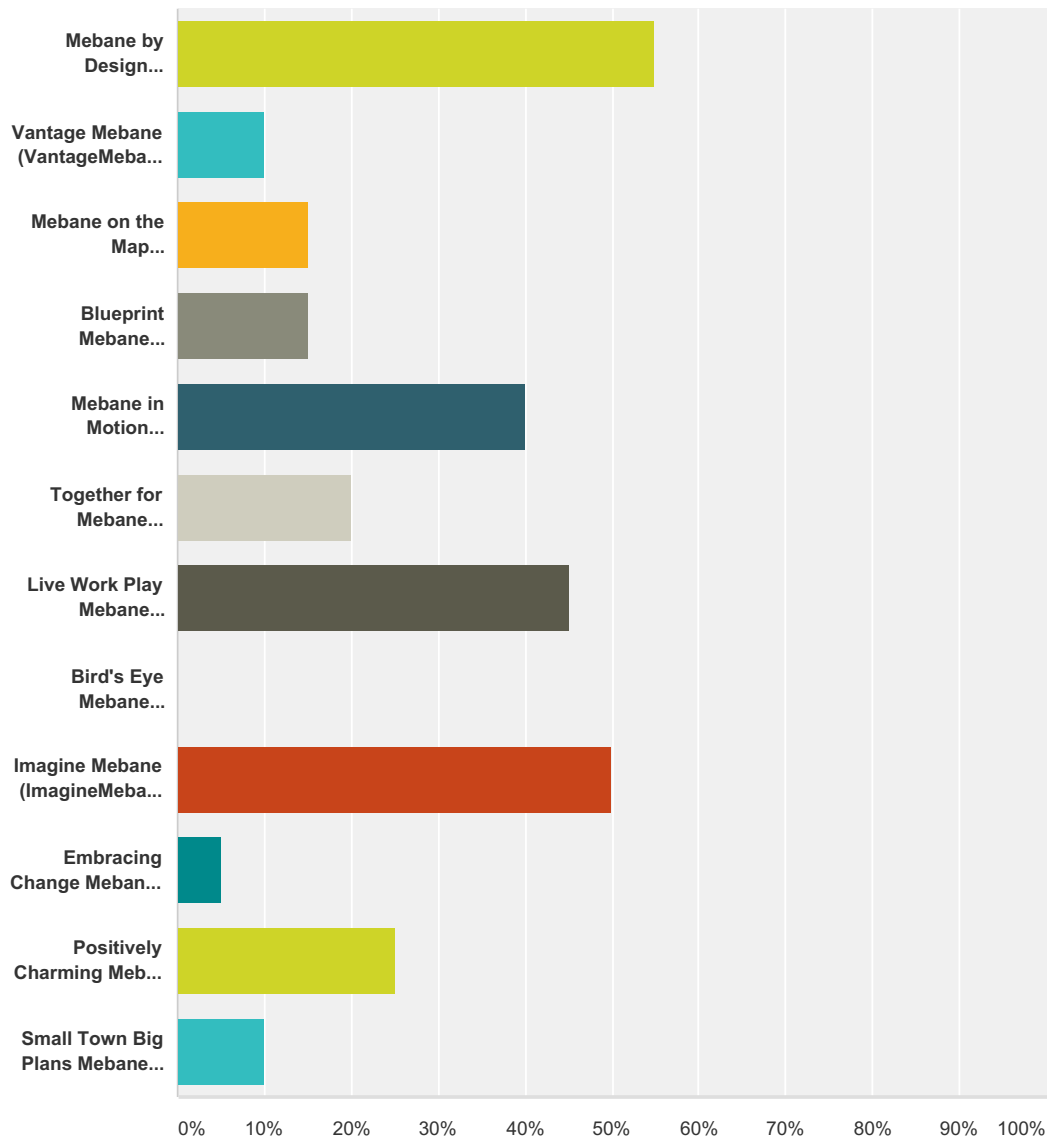
